### Entitlements for Employees registered prior to 1 July 2012

Credited Days	Basis of Claim
2200 + 10 years or more	<p><b><u>Long Service Leave/Payment</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ If employed – your employer will need to grant you permission to take leave (full completion of “Employers Declaration” required) and if payment only (full completion of “Employers Confirmation” required).</li> <li>▪ If unemployed – answer no to “Are you currently employed?” therefore “Employer’s Declaration” section not required to be completed.</li> </ul>
1100 – 2199 Less than 10 years but more than 5 years	<p><b><u>Leaving the Industry</u></b></p> <p>It must be your intention not to return to work in the building and construction industry.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Statutory Declaration will need to be completed on the claim form stating your intended occupation. There is a mandatory 20 week waiting period from the date you finished working in the industry before receiving payment.</li> </ul>
55 – 1099 Less than 5 years	<p><b><u>Total Incapacity</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A certification on our claim form from a medical practitioner stating the nature of your illness or injury and that you are unable to return to work in the building and construction industry.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Age Retirement (55 years of age) or Veteran Affairs Pensioner</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Copy of birth certificate, driver’s licence or passport as proof of age.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Deceased</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Beneficiary to provide death certificate and complete a statutory declaration.</li> </ul>

2200 + 10 years or more	<p><b><u>Long Service Leave claim (payment claim not applicable)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ If employed – your employer will need to grant you permission to take leave (full completion of “Employers Declaration” required)</li> <li>▪ If unemployed – answer no to “Are you currently employed?” therefore “Employer’s Declaration” section not required to be completed.</li> </ul>
1540 – 2199 Less than 10 years but more than 7 years	<p><b><u>Leaving the Industry</u></b></p> <p>It must be your intention not to return to work in the building and construction industry.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Statutory Declaration will need to be completed on the claim form stating your intended occupation. There is a mandatory 20 week waiting period from the date you finished working in the industry before receiving payment.</li> </ul>
1100 – 1540 More than 5 years	<p><b><u>Total Incapacity</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A certification on our claim form from a medical practitioner stating the nature of your illness or injury and that you are unable to return to work in the building and construction industry.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Age Retirement (55 years of age) or Veteran Affairs Pensioner</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Copy of birth certificate, driver’s licence or passport as proof of age.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Deceased</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Beneficiary to provide death certificate and complete a statutory declaration.</li> </ul>
